To promote excellence in Key Stage 2 across Maths and English through interventions for all.

## Context of my project

As Head of Year 3 and overseeing the progress of Key Stage 2 children as a whole, I wanted to embed change across our Key Stage 2. This linked to our SDP 2.1 Year Goals Priority 1 Promoting Excellence in Key Stage 2. This had been borne out of establishing a new KS2 team this year, rewriting planning, establishing new assessment protocols and trying to streamline the KS into one.

## In the beginning......

- 1. Carry out Pupil Progress Meetings
- 2. Identify categories all KS children fell into
- 3. Identify weaknesses and strengths in learning
- 4. Share my plan with my team and enthuse.
- 5. Meet as a team and establish which staff would be leading which intervention group

# The results so far

Year 3— English ARE or above: 40 out of 47 pupils

Maths ARE or above: 42 out of 47 pupils

(those who did not meet have significant needs / levels of learning was significantly below at start of year)

Year 4— English ARE or above: 26 out of 30 (below include 2 with EHCP's) 1 GD and 1 ADHD)

Maths ARE or above: 28 out of 30 (1 below has EHCP for global delay)

Intervention cycles run on 6 week basis

Reviewed after each cycle for movement between groups.

PP meetings allow progress check

Increased importance of interventions

Stigma being removed and children enthused
